## **Fence Improvements to Enhance Safety at Municipal Airport**

**Lloydminster, AB/SK** – During the regular City Council meeting on Monday, June 12, 2017, City Council voted to amend the 2017 Capital Budget to include an \$80,000 investment in additional perimeter fencing at the Airport.

Currently, wildlife and unauthorized personnel are able to access the aircraft-movement area, posing a significant safety risk. In recent weeks, Airport staff have encountered buffalo, deer and bears within the airport facility.

The cost of the required fencing improvements is supported by the Alberta Federal Gas Tax Funds.
