City Partners with Lloydminster Community Youth Centre to Remove Graffiti

Lloydminster, AB/SK – On July 6, 2017 Youth volunteers removed graffiti along walking trails between 36 Street and 31 Street. The program is the result of a partnership between the Lloydminster Community Youth Centre and the City of Lloydminster that began in 2016.

The partnership had originally developed as a result of the City receiving numerous graffiti complaints along the trails near Anniversary Park. It was determined this would be a great opportunity to showcase the positive impact youth can have in our community and encourage their involvement in volunteerism. Lloydminster Home Depot supported the initiative by providing the supplies.

This year, youth will tackle additional properties along the walking trails between 36 Street and 31 Street. Residents and businesses wishing to donate to the program may contact the Lloydminster Community Youth Centre. All residents are encouraged to take care of graffiti on their property as soon as it occurs in accordance with the Community Standards Bylaw.

At this time, the focus of the program are the areas surrounding the walking trails. Future graffiti clean-up dates are scheduled for August 10 and August 24, 2017.
