Motorists Advised of Detours as Repairs Completed on 40 Avenue

Lloydminster, AB/SK – As part of the 2016 Street Improvement Program (SIP), the City of Lloydminster Engineering Services Team will be conducting repairs along 40 Avenue north of the Landfill.

The work on 40 Avenue includes:

- removal and replacement of old culverts
- repairs to roadway
- repair to shoulders
- re-paving of the street

Work is expected to begin Wednesday, October 12, 2016, ending Wednesday, October 19, 2016.

There will be road closures and major delays on 40 Avenue while work is completed. Detours will be available through 67 Street, Four Mile Road and Hwy 17, as needed.

The 2016 SIP consists of work at 22 locations throughout the City and includes sidewalk repairs, curb and gutter repairs, walking path upgrades, intersection rehabilitations, roadway patching and addition of turning lanes. SIP updates are posted to the City website at www.lloydminster.ca.
