Wounded Warriors Weekend - July 27 - 31, 2017 On behalf of City Council, Mayor Aalbers declared July 27-31, 2017 as 'Wounded Warriors Weekend' in Lloydminster.

HIGHLIGHTS
City Manager's Office

1. In accordance with the Governance Audit recommendations, the City Manager, together with the Executive, have reviewed all positions within the City of Lloydminster and determined an update to the functional structure and position classifications was required. Council approved, in principle, five Executive Management positions and a list of Senior Executives who will, on occasion, be appointed to act as City Manager in the City Manger's absence.

Community Services

1. Council approved the 2017 FCSS Special Projects grant allocations to 11 non-profit organizations and their programming, ranging from \$1,000 to \$5,000, and Council authorized the FCSS Advisory Committee to reallocate any unused/declined grant funds.
2. Council did not accept the Lloydminster and District Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Lloydminster SPCA) request for exemption from the 2017 Property Tax Levy, but suggested that Administration work with the Lloydminster SPCA to find a solution.

Business Services

1. Council authorized the migration of the Exchange on-premise environment to the Microsoft Exchange

Online product offering, for an amount of \$13,125 in consulting services from Compugen, and \$7,056 in subscription fees from Microsoft, and that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign and seal all documents.

Operations

1. Council granted first reading of Bylaw 21-2017 being the bylaw to redistrict 34 properties along Highway 16. This will ensure that the properties along Highway 16 (44 Street) will align with the intent of Land Use Bylaw 5-2016. Council established a Public Hearing to be held at City Hall Council Chambers during Regular Council Meeting on August 15, 2017 at 2:00 p.m.
2. Council approved and executed the Purchase and Sales Agreement of 0.022 ha (0.06 ac) of Plan 4236HW: All that portion of lane, south of the south boundaries of lots A and B, Block 1, Plan 4203MC, lying within the limits of proposed Lot "10", Block 1, Plan 172 ; (within S.F. 1/4 Sec. 12 — Twp. 50 — Rge. 01 — W4M). Parkland Fuel Corporation will purchase the area from the City at a price of \$36,900.00 in order to accommodate parking for the FasGas service station.

Bylaws

1. Bylaw 16-2017, being a road closure bylaw, was given second and third (final) reading.
