

Airport Safety Policy

It is our intent to operate the Lloydminster Airport as efficiently as possible with safety as a prime consideration. Through the introduction of a Safety Management System we are committing to provide a systematic, explicit, and comprehensive process for managing airside risks. In conjunction with the City of Lloydminster's Certificate of Recognition for Health and Safety Management, we strive to have the two Safety Management Systems be collaborative and cooperative not only with the goal to meet, but to where possible exceed safety standards.

By embracing this Safety Management System, we will be able to establish safety as an integral part of our airport culture which will include:

- Recognizing that safety is paramount
- Minimizing the risks associated with aircraft operations
- Developing and continuously improving the airport's safety processes and performance
- Identifying hazards, assessing risks and implementing control measures
- Documenting safety activities and maintaining records
- Auditing our system on a regular basis

The reporting of any real or perceived safety issue is essential to the success of our Safety Management System and is encouraged. Therefore, anyone who reports an aviation safety issue or makes suggestion that seeks to improve aviation safety will not be subject to disciplinary action except in cases involving unlawful acts, gross negligence, or wilful violations where the individual is deemed responsible.

To be effective, our Safety Management System must work from the bottom up and to do that it must have support from the top down. I am committed to providing the support as to encourage everyone to become actively involved in the management of airside safety risks at our airport.

The City of Lloydminster Airport will comply with applicable Federal legislation.
