Preamble

In 2018 the City of Lloydminster's Social Programs and Services (SPS) department held the first Social Needs Assessment. In 2022 the City held another assessment to connect with residents, stakeholders and local partners, and gain a better understanding of the current social needs of Lloydminster.

To do this, City Administration launched the Lloyd Needs survey. This survey was shared with residents of Lloydminster and the surrounding area from April 11 to May 30, 2022. The data in this report reflects the input of 2,003 participants. The last Lloyd Needs survey in 2017 received 2,168 responses.

The findings of this survey will guide the Social Needs Assessment Report which will highlight the community needs and recommendations. The information in the assessment report will be used to create a five to ten-year Social Policy Framework in 2023. A Social Policy Framework provides direction and support to City initiatives that will have an impact on Lloydminster's social well-being.

Engagement Strategy

The City of Lloydminster worked closely with community partners who were involved in the development of the survey¹ to ensure that the data collected would be relevant and appropriate. The City offered special presentations, workshops and ran a survey table (lemonade stand) at different locations in the community². The success of this survey would not have been possible without the support of our many local service providers and their connection to the residents of this community.

The City of Lloydminster partnered with the Lloydminster Youth Council to develop a modified version of the Lloyd Needs Survey which was targeted toward youths ages 13 to 18. Youth Council members developed marketing materials, promoted in schools, and collected a total of 315 survey responses.


A variety of means were used to ensure that residents were aware of the Lloyd Needs Survey and had an opportunity to participate. Print and electronic surveys were provided to residents at a variety of venues and best efforts were made to ensure all members of the community had an opportunity to participate. A total of 131 paper copies of the survey were collected.











This final comment section received 401 responses.⁴⁴ The following responses come directly from survey submissions based on tone of the topic addressed.

94 comments related to recreation.

- Another indoor swimming pool. I know many people who would utilize a pool more if there was more public swimming. With lessons, swim club and synchro, the pool has limited public access.
- Our community desperately needs more INDOOR recreation opportunities for families. We have ALOT of
 large families in this region and very few affordable options for physical activities during the long winter
 months.

44 comments related to a need for public transportation:

- Public transit is the backbone of livable cities. Better transit means less congestion, faster community, more convenience high productivity and better emissions
- I truly believe there needs to be a bus system in this city. Taxis are too expensive to use to get to and from work daily and get other necessities.
- Lloydminster is in need of public transportation. We are forgetting a portion of our community that struggles financially and is limited to accessing affordable transportation.

43 comments related to **safety**.

- I think the crime in this town is getting insane. Theft and creeps around schools and feel very unsafe going to the post office even in daylight.
- Reduce crime and gang activity. Lloyd does not feel safe, especially at night. Revitalize downtown.
- I wish there were more of a police presence on residential streets at night times for patrolling, and photo radar because there are so many speeders that rev their engines and I worry to let my kids play outside.

40 comments related to road maintenance and repair.

Roads are atrocious and never get repaired properly

32 comments related to sidewalks and pathways.

- I strongly believe we need a better trail/sidewalk system in the entire city of Lloydminster, connecting all areas. We have many running groups and people who walk to all places, and they should not have to share the road.
- Sidewalks need to be fixed for better wheelchair and scooter access.

32 comments related to cost of living, affordability, and inflation.

- The groceries and utilities are so expensive, and I pay Alberta power and gas but don't get the rebate
- wages need to increase, there should be some kind of grants available to those that have a mortgage, for fixing up the home, so it remains in livable condition. Not everyone has a nest egg to fall back on when things go wrong. Most of us have to live, if you call it that, cheque to cheque, deciding whose name gets pulled out of the hat this cheque to be paid, and who has to wait. Then you worry bout disconnection notices because you couldn't make your payment

27 comments related to housing and homelessness.

- I think we need to deal with the homeless issue in Lloydminster. There needs to be a safe place for them to go to get them off the streets at the very least so it will reduce the loitering a bit.
- There needs to be another drop-in center for the unhoused members of Lloydminster
