

BYLAW NO. 29-2016

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF LLOYDMINSTER
IN THE PROVINCES OF ALBERTA AND
SASKATCHEWAN TO AMEND BYLAW NO.
5-2016, BEING THE "LAND USE BYLAW OF
THE CITY OF LLOYDMINSTER"

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Lloydminster Charter* and the *Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000*, the City is granted the power to pass bylaws for municipal purposes;

NOW THEREFORE the Council in the City of Lloydminster in the Provinces of Alberta AND Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

That Bylaw No. 5-2016 entitled "The Land Use Bylaw of the City of Lloydminster", is hereby amended in the manner set forth:

Section 5.2 be deleted and replaced with:

"Alcohol Sales shall be located only on a Site with a minimum radial separation of a 100 m or more from the Site boundary of any Site with an existing community or recreation activity, a Public Park or a School."

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
