BYLAW N. 24-69

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF LLOYDMINSTER, IN THE PROVINCES OF SASKATCHEVAN AND ALBERTA TO DESIGNATE 44TH STREET IN THE CITY OF LLOYDMINSTER, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA AS A CONTROLLED STREET

WHEREAS by virtue of Section 36 of The Public Highways Development Act S.A. 1966 C. 79 the Council may by bylaw designate any street of the City as a controlled street;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable that 44th Street in the City of Lloydminster, in the Province of Alberta, be designated as a controlled Street.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Lloydminster hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT 44th Street in the City of Lloydminster, in the Province of Alberta, being that portion of 44th Street extending from its intersection with 50th Avenue west to the City limits, is hereby designated as a controlled street pursuant to the Public Highways Development Act S.A. 1966 C. 79.
- 2. THIS Dylaw shall take effect from the date of final passing thereof.
