- 1. Refer to the Constitution Act, 1982 (Canada), School Act (Province of Alberta) and The Education Act (Province of Saskatchewan) regarding regulations for school support declarations.
- 2. The above noted Legislation provides that where the minority religious faith, whether Protestant or Roman Catholic, has established a separate school division, a property owner is to be assessed with respect to his/her property
 - (a) in the case of a member of the minority religious faith, as a taxpayer of the separate school division:
 - (b) in any other case, as a taxpayer of the public school division.
- 3. If a property is held by 2 or more individuals as joint tenants or tenants in common, each holder is to be assessed in proportion to his/her interest in the property for the public or separate school division of which he/she is a taxpayer for school purposes.

Facts Sheet

- In the City of Lloydminster, both a public and a separate school district exist.
- When property is sold, the purchaser is required to file with the City of Lloydminster this School Support Declaration.
- In addition, property owners can at any time file a new School Support Declaration or change an existing School Support Declaration.
- A School Support Declaration filed by a property owner is effective in the taxation year following the year in which the School Support Declaration is filed.
- Individual property owners who are Roman Catholic must direct their property taxes to the Roman Catholic separate school district.
- Individual property owners who are not Roman Catholic must direct their taxes to the Lloydminster Public School district.
- Only property owners, **not tenants**, are entitled to file this School Support Declaration.
- If property is owned by a Roman Catholic and a non-Roman Catholic, the **City of Lloydminster** will assign the taxes to the public and Roman Catholic separate school districts in accordance with the percentage of ownership indicated by the land title.
- In order to ensure that property taxes are directed correctly, it is important that all property owners file a School Support Declaration.
- The School Support Declaration applies to all property within the **City of Lloydminster** owned by individuals whether or not the property owners reside within the **City of Lloydminster**.
- If this School Support Declaration is not returned to the City of Lloydminster, the individual owner's
 property will be assessable for public school purposes and the taxes on such property will be directed
 to the Public School district.
- Because the Constitution establishes public and separate school systems on the basis of religion (either Protestant or Roman Catholic) school boards and tax collecting authorities are allowed and required to ask for the declaration contained in this form.
