A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF  
LLOYDMINSTER IN THE PROVINCES OF  
SASKATCHEWAN AND ALBERTA TO  
AMEND A BYLAW TO ADOPT AN  
INTERMUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN,  
FUTURE LAND USE

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLOYDMINSTER in the Provinces of Saskatchewan and Alberta enacts as follows:

That the Intermunicipal Development Plan is hereby amended in the manner set forth:

1. The most northerly 72 acres in the SW 16-50-1W4, as shown in Map #A, Future Land Use, is amended by redesignating that area from:

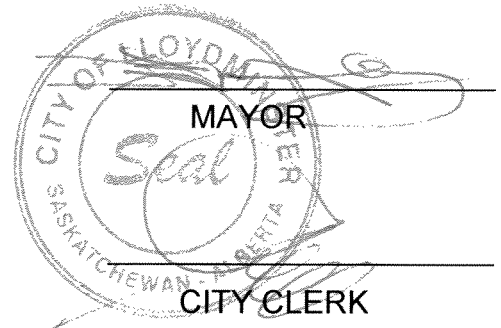
**AP – Airport Protection to  
RCI – Rural Commercial Industrial**

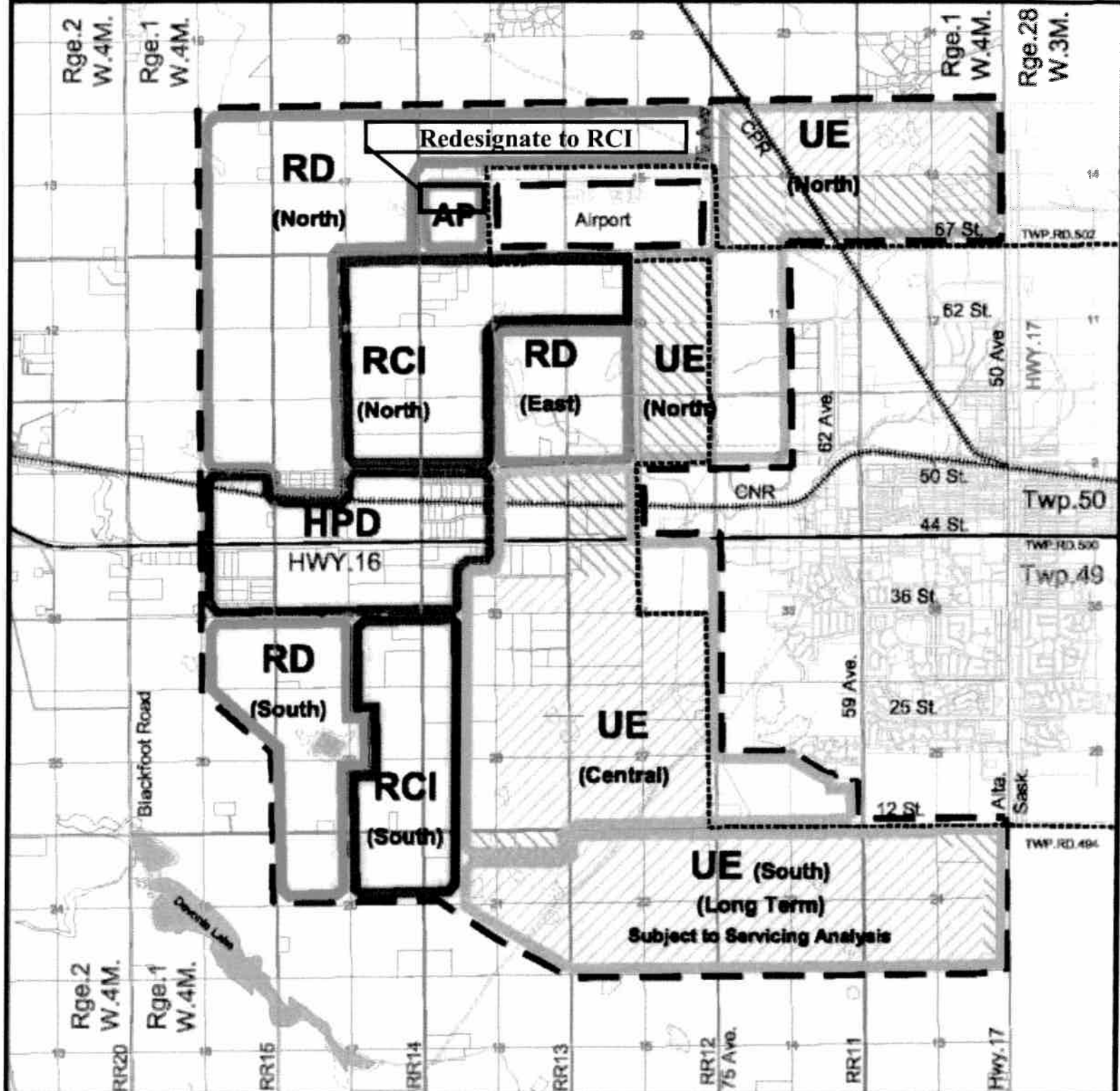
This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
